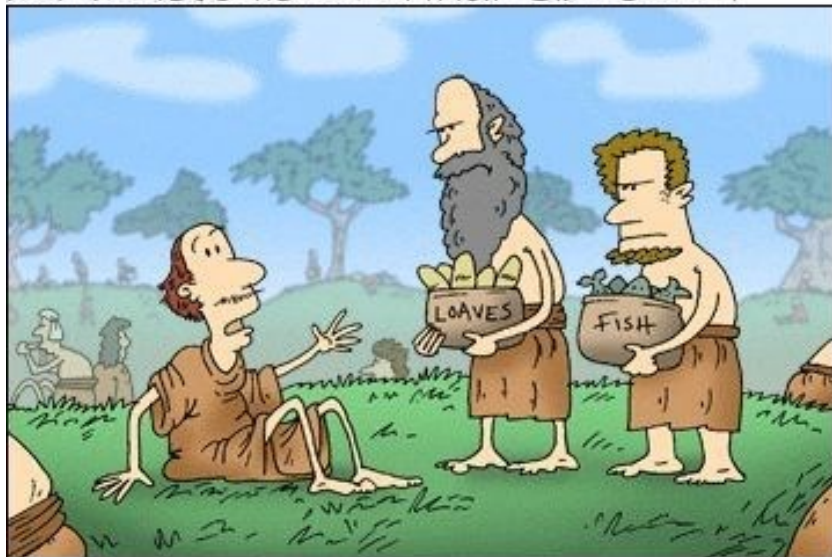

The Bible Readings for today - 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

2 Samuel 7: 1-14a

Ephesians 2: 11-22

Mark 6: 30-34, 53-56

Today's readings pick up on the traditional picture of a leader as a shepherd, sharing God's qualities of compassion and concern for the needs of the flock.

The opening verse of Mark's Gospel describes the return of the twelve, sent out in pairs with Jesus' authority, exhausted and excited. Jesus and his disciples try and escape the crowds to find rest, but lots of desperate, sick people follow him, hoping to be healed. Jesus is the supreme example of how a shepherd should attend to the sheep: teaching, guiding and healing.

All: **We come to offer you our joys and struggles.**

Leader: We bring our tiredness and lay it down. We bring our hurts and lay them down. We bring our hopes and offer them up to you,
