The Bible Readings for today - 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

2 Samuel 1: 1, 17-27 2 Corinthians 8: 7-15 Mark 5: 21-43

INTRODUCTION

Last week we heard of Jesus challenging the disciples about their fear of the storm and of their lack of faith. Jesus will be there at all times for us when life is tough as long as we believe in him and his love for us. Today we hear of two physical healings when these people have such strong faith. The leader of the synagogue and his little daughter dying, and the woman with the years of haemorrhaging. She was healed by her faith, practically without Jesus knowing. For the leader who learned that his daughter had died, Jesus' response was 'Do not fear, only believe'. And they carried on and Jesus healed her. It is a strong ask to trust so implicitly, especially when we sometimes do not see the healing or help! Sometimes we have to look for it in other ways. Both these scriptures are teaching us to believe no matter what, to know that Jesus cares and loves us, and will be there in times of trouble or sickness **somehow**. And in all our circumstances we remember to give him thanks.
