The Bible Readings for today - 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

2 Samuel 5: 1-5, 9-10 2 Corinthians 12: 2-10 Mark 6: 1-13

In our Old Testament reading we hear about David becoming king as the people wanted. In the gospel reading we hear about Jesus calling the twelve disciples and then sending them out to preach and heal. All actions as part of God's will, and for the future of God's kingdom. Without King David, we would not have the basis for Jesus's life and mission. Without the disciples we would not have Jesus' mission and gospel to continue spreading throughout the world. Finally looking at the epistle reading in 2nd Corinthians, Paul shared with us the means by which he managed to minister the gospel. He told us God said 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness'. This is a great message and one we can all hold onto as such an encouragement for our ministries!
