INTRODUCTION

Through the 'blessed's' and 'woe's' in Luke's Beatitudes Jesus shows us the way to look toward God, to turn to God for help in our lives and in our attitudes and in our values. If we can recognize our need we can begin to learn where God leads us. We can understand the necessity of seeking God. Our deep sense of helplessness brings us before God just as we are – not as we imagine ourselves to be. We can recognize the power of God that can transform us into the happy, complete, caring and loving people Jesus calls us to be.

All: **for they will be comforted.**

Notices:

We have moved to services under ‘Traffic Light Red’ which requires each person to show a Vaccine Pass in order to attend a service. Most aspects of our services remain as they have under Level 2: mask wearing in the service, only bread at communion, no offertory taken during the service (the collection plate is at the back of the church for you to put in your gift to support the Church), and appropriate distancing. However we can now have morning tea in our usual manner without having to be served at the table.

We have introduced a communion service on Wednesday afternoons at 1pm at St Ambrose at which vaccine passes will not be required to be shown. The Transitional Cathedral is also offering service at 12:15pm on Sundays that does not require the showing of a vaccine pass.

Recently a donation of garden soil was received from Phil Mauger. It was made to enable repairs to the garden beds at St Ambrose after completion of all the earthquake repairs. A very generous donation and much appreciated. Rev Felicity is looking to organise a working bee to make progress on restoring the garden to a relatively maintenance-free state.

In preparation for Ash Wednesday, any palm crosses from last year can be given to Anne, Felicity or Brenda.

We are looking at what times we will hold Lenten study groups and will be putting out information and sign-up sheets for these soon.
