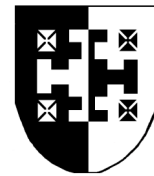

**INTRODUCTION**

Abraham is our example of a life lived faithfully in response to God's leading. Abraham was willing to go where God led, not knowing what would happen along the way. He was a pilgrim and so lived by faith; living with uncertainty and journeying into the unknown. We can try to plan our lives and to be prepared for every eventuality but the only certainty – and the one we must hold on to – is that God is with us and wants us to be part of the Kingdom of God. Living a Christian life doesn't mean that all will go smoothly and well for us, but it does mean that we live hopefully and in the assurance that we are not alone on the journey.
