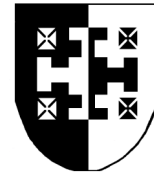

INTRODUCTION

Mary was afraid on hearing the greeting of the angel Gabriel. Joseph was afraid when he found that Mary was expecting a child. And the shepherds were afraid when the angel appeared to them and the glory of the Lord shone round them. All of us are touched by fear. What we have to do is move from fear to faith and trust is the thing that enables us to turn fear into faith. Somehow it's easier to trust in God at Christmas than at any other time, because we feel that God is very close to us as God comes to us in form of the child Jesus. Christmas challenges us to enter into an intimate relationship with God, trusting that we will receive love, and always more love.

Call to Worship:

Leader: We are always looking for evidence that God is with us.
All: That sign is in the One to come--the One that God is sending.

Leader: We want to know for sure that everything is in God's care.
All: And so we cry to the heavens in our distress. Our cries are heard! God is responding in love and hope.

Leader: Let us come before God with expectant hearts and spirits!
All: Let us be ready to receive the blessed gift of the Saviour.

Sentence: (for 4th Sunday of Advent)

A virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel: God with us.
Matthew 1:23

Collect: (for 4th Sunday of Advent)

Living God, you called your people out of Egypt and gave them the covenant; prepare our hearts to hear your call, so that we may receive with joy the gospel of your Son and be your faithful people, now and for ever. Amen.

Notices:

Bishop Peter has written to clergy concerning the increasing number of Covid cases and has recommended that we encourage people to mask for services.
