

INTRODUCTION

We are on something of an adventure as a nation as we make significant steps forward to becoming a bicultural and bilingual society. Last Friday was our first public holiday which acknowledges something of importance in Te Ao Maori: Matariki. In this holiday we are invited to share together in celebrating the appearance of the astronomical sign which heralds the turn of the year and to remember with thanksgiving those who have gone before us. Matariki refers to both the cluster of stars called Pleiades in ancient Greece (and continued as a term in modern English) and to one of those stars. Potentially we can see seven stars, though one may be hidden.

Call to Worship

Leader: And all our people will sing together .

All: **Wairua Tapu, holy is your name.**

Leader: There's one great Spirit in all creation.

All: **One great Spirit of God!**

Sentence:

Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for Jesus' sake will find it. *Matthew 10:39*

Collect:

Gracious God, as we contemplate the stars of Matariki, we clearly see that every part of Creation has its origin and purpose in you.
We give you thanks that you have given life to our ancestors, grandparents and parents, so that they may transmit life to us.
You have also filled them with good things so we may inherit them by knowing you, adoring you, and serving you.
Bless us as we give thanks for those who have gone before us. Bestow your graces abundantly upon our ancestors, grandparents and parents, so that we may in our turn inherit their blessings.
We ask this through Jesus Christ who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God now and forever. Amen

Today we have our first celebration of Matariki at which we will remember our ancestors and what legacy they have left us, and think about what we will leave for those who come after us. At each site the service will be followed by a special morning tea.
