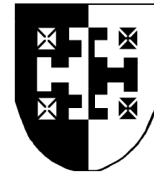

**INTRODUCTION**

Jesus' extravagant miracle of changing the water into wine is a sign that in him, life, joy, and salvation have arrived. Abundant life is more than mere existence or survival, and certainly more than an abundance of material things. Abundant life is to have an intimate relationship with the One who loves us so much that he doesn't know how to stop giving. It is the kind of life depicted by the abundance of fine wine in the wedding at Cana. Abundant life means that in Christ we are joined to the source of true life, life that is rich and full and eternal, life that neither sorrow, nor suffering, nor death itself can destroy.
