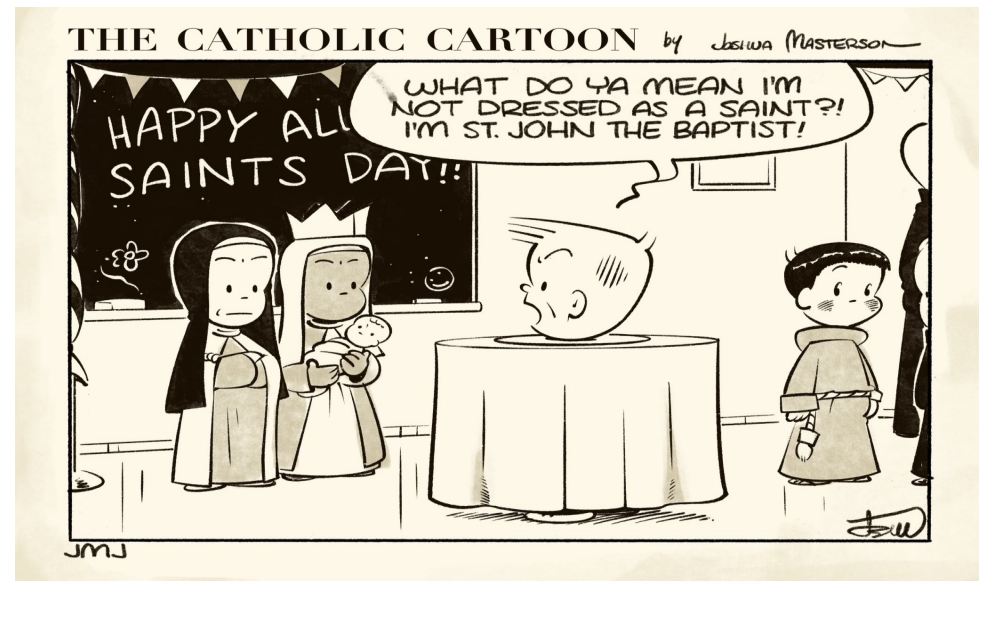

INTRODUCTION

This weekend brings us to celebrating both All Saints Day on 1st and All Souls on 2nd November.

May we indeed rejoice and give thanks for all those who have gone before us. As Bishop Peter says, "All the saints" means all those who live in relationship with Jesus Christ: the departed and the living, the dead-but-now-raised, and those alive on earth today. Death does not break down our fellowship with the saints. Today we join their celebration of resurrection life, and their example inspires us to continue faithfully walking by faith towards our full life with them, when earthbound time ends and complete fellowship with God begins.
