

INTRODUCTION

In our Gospel today Jesus sends two of his disciples to fetch a donkey on which he will ride into Jerusalem. As Jesus rides towards Jerusalem, bystanders greet him with shouts of acclamation. Some spread their cloaks, and others leafy branches, on the road as he passes by. When he reaches Jerusalem, Jesus goes immediately to the Temple. Jesus, king extraordinary, calls us to fight with him against the world's evils, but also promises us peace and reconciliation. We pray for courage to follow his example, patience to keep working at self-control and peace-making, and thankful hearts for the power for good that love brings.
