### **INTRODUCTION**

On Palm Sunday Jesus' disciples welcomed him into Jerusalem with joy and fanfare. They openly acknowledged their belief in him and loyalty to him. What made their display of support all the more praiseworthy was the fact that it was carried out in the teeth of bitter opposition from the Pharisees. It was the only time that Jesus accepted something akin to hero-worship from his disciples. He knew that his disciples had a right and a need to express publicly their belief in him. There are times we too need to profess our faith in Jesus publicly. And there are times when the occasion cries out for it. Let us not remain silent when a word cries out to be said.

### **Call to Worship:**

Leader: Through the hosannas and the waving palms, the singing and the joy, come, and walk the road with Christ.

**All: Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.  
We will walk with him.**

Leader: Through the betrayal and the denial, the shouting and the sorrow, come, and walk the road with Christ.

**All: Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world.  
We will walk with him.**

Leader: Through the waving palms and the passion, the prayers and the pain, come, and walk the road with him.

**All: We will walk with him. We will not leave him now.  
Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.**

**Sentence:**

At the name of Jesus, every knee shall bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. *Philippians 2:10-11*

**Collect:**

**God of saints and sinners,  
these palms will dry and fade,  
and shouts of ‘hosanna’ will change to ‘crucify’.  
Forgive our treachery,  
grant us faithfulness to follow Christ.  
Through Jesus Christ our Liberator,  
who is alive and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever. Amen**
