### **The Bible Readings for today - 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Isaiah 6: 1-8                      1 Corinthians 15: 1-11                      Luke 5: 1-11

### **INTRODUCTION**

Isaiah had a vision of God and was called to the prophetic role in 742 BCE. The content of his message, however, gave witness to a coming national catastrophe. Paul heard reports that some in Corinth deny the resurrection. He lists the resurrection appearances which he said he has already told them about. Luke's version of Jesus calling the first disciples stands out. In Mark's and Matthew's versions, Jesus tells the disciples that they will be fishing for people. Luke tells the longer story, which includes a miraculous catch of fish, through which Peter is enabled to recognize Jesus as Lord. In Luke's account there is also an exciting new idea: 'from now on' Jesus tells them, 'you will be catching people' (Luke 5:10). It sharpens the point of the story. We usually catch fish to eat them, but Jesus will catch us and enable us by the power of the Holy Spirit to catch all those who are seeking him!

### **Call to Worship**

**Leader:** I give thanks to you O Lord with all my heart: before the gods I will sing your praises.

**All:** **I bow down and give thanks because of your love and faithfulness: for you have exalted your name and your word above all things.**

**Leader:** On the day I called, you answered me: and put new strength within me.

**All:** **You will fulfil your purpose for me, your love O Lord is everlasting: do not leave unfinished the work of your hands.**

Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, and was buried, and was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures and appeared to many 1 Corinthians 15:3-4
