### INTRODUCTION

The two disciples on the road to Emmaus invite the stranger who has joined them to stay with them. Recognition fills them when he breaks the bread and offers it to them because of the familiar gesture of Jesus. They have seen the Lord. They must share it with the others and so they return to Jerusalem. They go to the same house where all are awake, rejoicing and sharing the good news with one another. "We have seen the Lord!" Cleopas and his wife add to the chorus: "Yes, he was known to us in the breaking of the bread." May he be known to us also in the breaking of the bread.
