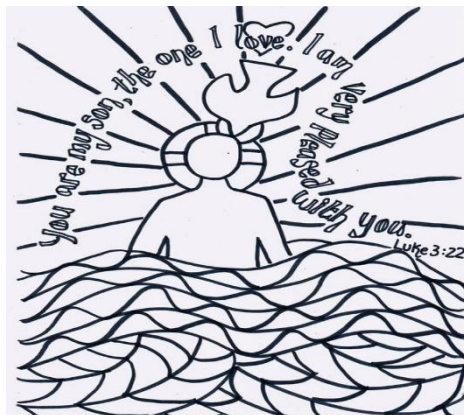

INTRODUCTION

Hope refreshed

In the first Reading the prophet Isaiah offers hope with his prophecy to people who are suffering in exile. He tells them about God's chosen servant who will bring justice, light and freedom from captivity to the nations.

Today we explore the hope that God gave to all people in his Son, Jesus, whose baptism we mark today, and how we might share God's hope with those who are in desperate need of it.
