INTRODUCTION

Today is **Ordinary 10, or Te Pouhere Sunday**.

In May 1992, the General Synod / Te Hinota Whanui adopted a revised Constitution / Te Pouhere, which established a three-Tikanga Church.

In 2002, on the 10th anniversary of that Constitution, the Synod/ Hinota thought it appropriate to commemorate the occasion of the revision of the Constitution / Te Pouhere of our three Tikanga Church.

A set of Lections (readings) were approved, along with a set of Collects (prayers) in the various languages of the Church described in the Constitution / Te Pouhere.

This Sunday is a day on which it is appropriate then to remember and celebrate the Constitution of this Church and to focus worship on the three Tikanga character of this Church.

Sentence
