The Bible Readings for today - 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jeremiah 32: 1-3a, 6-15 1 Timothy 6: 6-19 Luke 16: 19-31

INTRODUCTION

Jeremiah 32:1-3a, 6-15 “Jeremiah Buys a Field” – The imprisoned Jeremiah buys a plot of land at Anathoth, a village near Jerusalem. It is a daring sign that the people of God will eventually be restored to their homeland.

1 Timothy 6:6-19 “Pursing God’s Justice” – The writer challenges those who surround themselves with worldly securities.

Luke 16:19-31 “The Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus” – In this parable, Jesus contrasts the richness of heaven with the false riches of earth. There is a stark dichotomy between those with Lazarus and Abraham and those in Hades which is difficult to ignore. The great chasm cannot be bridged by easy answers. A heart without mercy can neither open itself to help others in need nor understand the grace offered through Jesus’ death and resurrection. The other startling reality is the silence of Lazarus, echoing the silence of many poor people in our society .

Sentence

‘Confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective.’
James 5:16
