Isaiah 35: 1-10 James 5: 7-10 Matthew 11: 2-11



From Bishop Peter:

This coming **Sunday, 14 December 2025** is **Advent 3.** The epistle reading is **James 5:7-10**. It is impossible to escape the words "patient/patience/endurance" when reading this passage (6x in the NRSV). In Advent we are challenged, as years go by and the Lord does not return, to "Be patient, therefore, beloved, until the coming of the Lord."

Sentence

Strengthen the weak hands, and make firm the feeble knees.
Say to those who are of a fearful heart, 'Be strong, do not fear!
Here is your God.'
